Horse Camp Reservations for Rancho del Oso can be made by calling Big Basin Redwoods Park Headquarters at (831) 338-8861, from 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM, Mondays through Fridays. There are six primitive campsites available year round.

You must have a reservation to camp at the Rancho del Oso Horse Camp.

Horse Camp Site:

- \$24 per site, per night
- \$10 per extra vehicle, per night

6 people /1 licensed vehicles/trailers per site. One horse per campsite.

Reservation/payment includes 1 vehicle and 1 legally towed vehicle/trailer per site. You need to have one horse for every campsite you reserve and due to the corral limitations you will need a campsite for every horse you bring.

The reservation and camping fees are paid using a credit or debit card when you make your reservation over the phone. The camping fee includes overnight parking for one vehicle. You will receive a parking pass attached to the confirmation e-mail. You must print and display the parking pass on the dashboard of that vehicle as proof of payment. Rangers will verify payment.

Extra vehicle fees apply if you park more than one vehicle in a State Park. Use the self-registration station for payment and pay with exact change or a check.

Arrival is any time after 2:00 pm on the day of your reservation. Check out time is at 12:00 pm.

Generators must be shut off at 8:00 pm, and Quiet Hours start at 10:00 pm.

Horses must be with a handler at all times. **Campers must remove horse droppings and place them in the designated area.** Trail maps are available at the Ranger Station, located near the Horse Camp. **Horses are not allowed on Waddell Beach.**

Dogs are not allowed at Rancho del Oso – Big Basin Redwoods State Park at any time.

- Grill (1 per site)
- Horse Corral – 10' x 10' (1 per site)
- Pipe Tie Rail – 6' (1 per site)
- Horse Watering Trough

- Fire Ring (1 central)
- Shovel and Wheelbarrow
